

EYEMOUTH HARBOUR LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS No.5 of 2024

Date of Issue: 27th June 2024.

- 1. Mariners are hereby advised that dredger will return shortly, and dredging operations will resume in Eyemouth Harbour beginning on, or around Saturday 29 June 2024.
- 2. MV Wyre Sands will resume dredging the Canyon Entrance and Basin, followed by other areas of the harbour.



- 3. All vessels must contact the Harbour Master when entering or leaving the harbour, using VHF Ch.12 or the mobile 07885 742 505.
- 4. Mariners are advised that temporary restrictions to vessel movements may occur and that they should navigate with caution. Further direction will be issued on this as required.
- 5. During this time, vessels may be required to move berth as directed by the Harbour Master, to facilitate dredging operations. Vessel's cooperation will be greatly appreciated.

6. For public safety and the work to be carried out efficiently the west pier will be temporarily fenced off from the halfway point. This is to mitigate any person getting too close to the vessel during dredging operations.
